



# MASTER 2 INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMME IN CANCER BIOLOGY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MONTPELLIER

The University, with the support of Montpellier SIRIC, offers a training opportunity for high-level students interested in Cancer Biology.

We recruit French and international candidates with scientific or medical background to follow an original curriculum of a Master 2 programme that covers fundamental, translational and clinic-oriented aspects of cancer.

Students follow five courses, of which three are specific of the Cancer Biology programme: Cell Fate and Plasticity, Principles of Cancer Biology and Cancer Therapy.

The two additional ones, common to all Health Science M2 programmes, are chosen from the following list: Genetics and Epigenetics, Cell signalling, Bioinformatics and Systems Biology, Integrative Physiopathology, Molecular Biophysics.

The theoretical courses, delivered in English, are complemented by seminars and workshops.

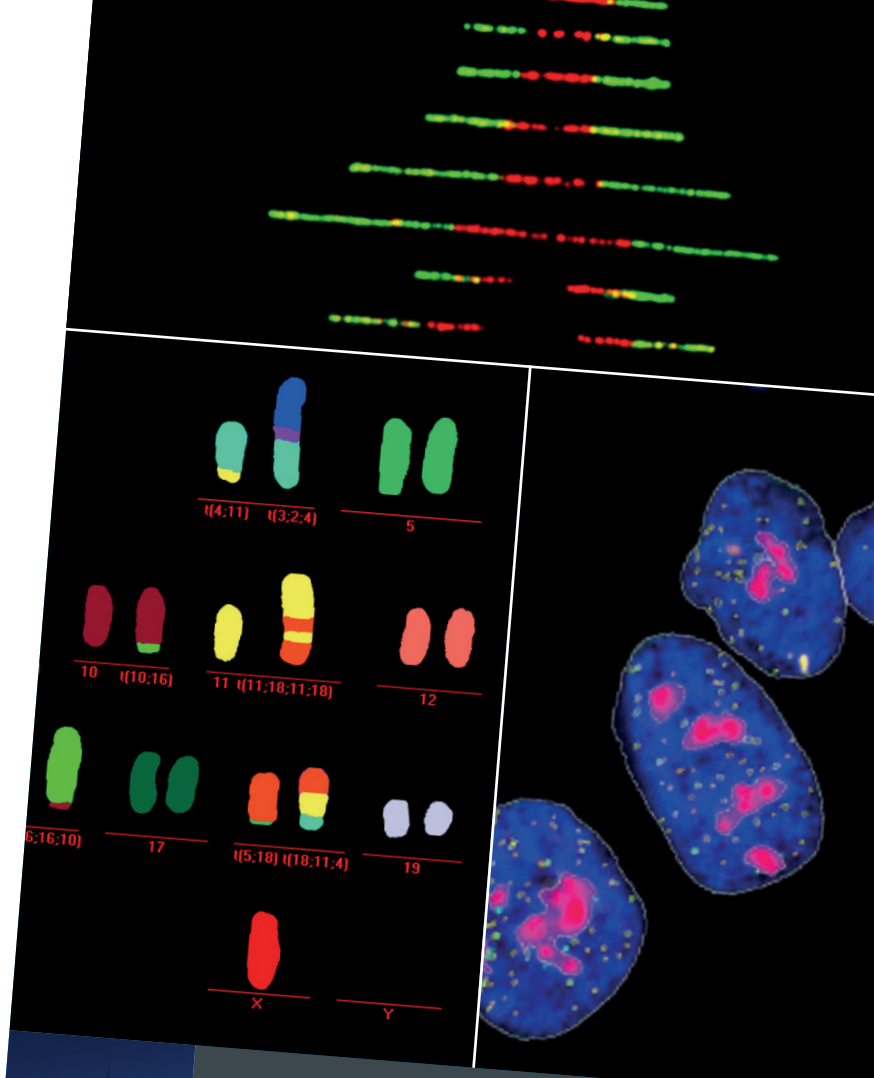
In the second semester students are exposed to a research experience through a long internship in one of the local research laboratories.

Successful completion of the programme gives 60 ECTS credits.
